Legislative Updates



Legislative Updates

Federal

- Budget Reconciliation: Budget reconciliation is a congressional process that sets funding rules for mandatory spending programs. Both chambers of Congress have agreed to the budget blueprint, unlocking the next phase of the reconciliation process — drafting legislative text and directing committees to find roughly \$4 billion in spending cuts over a decade. The House committees have started meeting and plan to have a vote on the House floor before the Memorial Day recess from May 26-30.
- **FY25-26 Appropriations:** Congress has also begun planning for FY26 appropriations, which will impact <u>discretionary</u> grants and programs. Federal grants and programs like CCDBG, TANF, and Head Start are funded through annual appropriations. The president is expected to send his full budget proposal to Congress any day now, but released a <u>"skinny" budget</u>.

Legislative Updates

State

- Money bills have been placed on special order for today.
 - House convenes at 11 AM
 - ECE investments have been held to the same amount as last year's investment at \$78 million; there has not been any additional investment made by the House.
 - The Revenue Estimating Conference should be scheduling a meeting soon.
- Rep. Emerson's bill rewriting Article VII of the Louisiana constitution has made it to the Senate and is awaiting committee referral.
- All hemp bills have been deferred.
- Rep. Riser's gaming bill is on hold as they work some things out.
 - Efforts to get a reduction in the tax rate percentage and find a compromise.
